

Addendum to the Agreement between Sapienza University of Rome – Faculty of Political Sciences, Sociology and Communication and Sciences Po Lille (Institut d'Etudes Politiques de Lille).

Sapienza University of Rome, represented by the Rectress, Prof. Antonella Polimeni, Città Universitaria, Piazzale Aldo Moro 5, 00185 Rome,

and

Sciences Po Lille, represented by the Director, Prof. Pierre Mathiot, 09 rue Angellier 59 000 Lille

given that

- ❖ the Agreement signed on 1st February 2021 between Sapienza University of Rome - Faculty of Political Sciences, Sociology, Communication and Sciences Po Lille (Institut d'Etudes Politiques de Lille) foresees its enforcement starting from the student cohort of the a. y. 2021-2022;
- ❖ Sciences Po Lille (Institut d'Etudes Politiques de Lille) enforced the Agreement to students enrolled in the a. y. 2020-2021, opening its selection procedures accordingly;
- ❖ it is thus necessary to amend and integrate the Agreement by enforcing, on an exceptional basis, its immediate effect;
- ❖ it appears necessary to proceed with further amendments and integrations to the signed Agreement, in order to clarify in no uncertain terms some procedural steps;

they agree and stipulate as follows

Art. 1 – Purpose

This Addendum amends and integrates the Agreement signed on 1st February 2021 between Sapienza University of Rome - Faculty of Political Sciences, Sociology, Communication and Sciences Po Lille (Institut d'Etudes Politiques de Lille).

Art. 2 - Introduction Article 13 Bis - Duration, renewal, and withdrawal

The Agreement, as referred to in art. 1, is integrated as follows:

Article 13 Bis - Duration, renewal, and withdrawal

This Agreement has a duration of six years and has an immediate effect from the study cycle activated in the a. y. 2020-2021. Therefore, students enrolled in their first year at their home university will be able to carry out their second year of studies at the partner institution, if they fall within the selected quota.

This Agreement can be renewed by signing a similar agreement between the parties.

Each party may withdraw from this Agreement even before its expiration, by giving written notice, which must be received by January of the academic year preceding the one for which it is willing to withdraw.

In the event of non-renewal or withdrawal, the parties are however obliged to carry out the commitments made with regards to the cohort of involved students.

Art. 2 – Amendment to Article 4 - Admission requirements and procedures

Article 4, paragraph 2, third line of the agreement is amended as follows:

- *For Sapienza students, the achievement of the Double degree requires the completion of both study cycles (degree plus master's degree, 5 years, 300 credits).*
- *Students enrolled at the study courses delivered by the Department of Political Sciences of Sapienza (L-16 and L-36), who will take part to the international programme attending one whole academic year at SPL, will attain, together with the bachelor degree at Sapienza, a Certificat d'Etudes Politiques - CEP.*
- *Students enrolled in a master's degree course delivered by the Department of Political Sciences of Sapienza (LM-52, LM-62, LM-63), who already attained the Certificat d'Etudes Politiques – CEP, can be directly included in the second cycle of the Double degree programme.*

Art. 3 - Amendment to the Article 5 - Student mobility

Article 5 of the Agreement is amended as follow:

3.1 At the end of paragraph 5.4, add: *up to a maximum of 9 ECTS.*

3.2 After paragraph 5.4, add the following paragraphs:

- 5.5 *Students who failed one or more exams at Sapienza are required to reset it/them, yet only once. Re-Examinations will be made and assessed by Sapienza but may be retaken at SPL after the students' arrival in Lille, up to a maximum of 9 ECTS.*
- 5.6 *Students from the two partner universities can be admitted to the Double degree programme only if they have acquired the number of credits required for the first year of the study course they belong to.*

Art. 4 - Amendment to the Article 7 – Degree

Article 7 of the Agreement is amended as follows:


7.1 *Upon successful completion of the Double degree programme (300 ECTS), four separate diplomas are awarded to the students according to the local regulations:*

- *Certificat d'Etudes Politiques (CEP) delivered by Sciences Po Lille;*
- *the degree from SPL: Diploma of Science Po Lille (Master's degree), together with diploma supplement, if available.*
- *the degree from Sapienza University of Rome: Bachelor's Degree in Political Sciences and International Relations (L-36) or Administration and Organization Sciences (L-16);*
- *the degree from Sapienza University of Rome: Master Degree in Political Sciences (LM-62) or International Relations (LM-52) or Sciences of Administration and Public Policies (LM-63) delivered by Sapienza, Department of Political Sciences, together with diploma supplement, if available.*

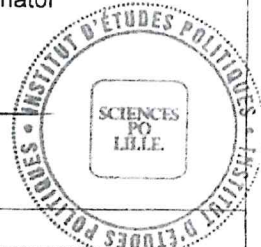
Art. 5 – Final Regulations

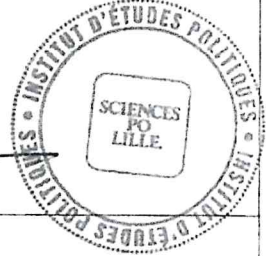

